

There will be accepted from this sale 12 acres 2 rods and 30 perches, more or less; leaving the size of the farm 194 acres 2 rods and 5 perches, more or less.

The 12 acres 2 rods and 30 perches accepted from the sale, are described ~~in~~ by course and distance, in two surveys, one made March 17th 1859 containing 7 acres 3 rods and 9 perches and the other made February 3rd 1864 containing 4 acres 3 rods and 21 perches.

The plats of these surveys are in the papers in this case No. 4880 Equity, and now in the possession of F. P. Nelson the trustee.
