Stier, To Nannie F. Stier and Marsaline Stier Twenty five dollars each. To Jay Hugh Stier, my set ring and any book of mine he would like to have. To Gertrude Russell and Elizabeth F. Cecil my suit of bedroom furniture, consisting of bedstead & the mattress and feather bed on it, bureau & washstand, and morris chair. To Alma D. Stier all my Jewelry, my books, silver, cut glass, & china the balance of my money the rest and residue of my estate of whatsoever kind I may die seized and possessed real & personal, all I give and bequeath to my sister Alma D. Stier. I do constitute and appoint my sister Alma D. Stier and my brother Dr. Jay Hugh Stier to be the executors of this my last will and testament of whom the Court shall require no bond.
