LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

OF

GEORGE S. COOPER

---

I, GEORGE S. COOPER, of the City of Pittsburgh, County of Allegheny and State of Pennsylvania, being of sound mind and memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament, in manner and form following; hereby revoking any will or wills heretofore made by me.

FIRST: I direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses be fully paid and satisfied, as soon as conveniently may be, after my decease.

SECOND: I give and bequeath my automobiles and household furnishings to my wife, MARY M. COOPER.

THIRD: I give and bequeath my jewelry and personal effects to my children living at the time of my decease.

FOURTH: All the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, real, personal and mixed, wheresoever situate, of which I may die seized or possessed or to which I may be entitled at the time of my death, and any property over which I may have or may hereafter acquire any power of appointment, I give, devise and bequeath as follows:

(a) To my wife, MARY M. COOPER, the one-third thereof, provided she is living at the expiration of six months after the date of my death. If my said wife should predecease me or be not living at the expiration of six months after the date of my death, then I give, devise and bequeath said one-third to my then living lawful issue, per stirpes and not per capita.
