The above cause standing ready for hearing and being submitted, the bill, answer, testimony and all other proceedings were by the Court read and considered.

It is thereupon this 3rd day of March, in the year 1938, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, in Equity, adjudged, ordered and decreed that the order nisi passed in this cause on the 13th day of August, in the year 1937, be and it is hereby modified by reducing the amount therein directed to be paid to the plaintiff, Minnie E. Nichols, by the defendant, Harry J. Nichols, from the sum of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars per month to the sum of Eighteen (\$18.00) Dollars per month, accounting from the 13th day of August, 1937, to the date of this decree, and it is further ordered and decreed that said order nisi be and it is hereby made absolute as herein modified, and that all sums due and owing under this modified decree amounting to the sum of \$117.00, alimony pendente lite, and \$25.00 Counsel fee to H. Kieffer DeLauter, Solicitor for plaintiff, be paid forthwith by the defendant to the plaintiff and her said Solicitor respectively. And it is further adjudged, ordered and decreed that the plaintiff, Minnie E. Nichols, be and she is hereby divorced A VINCULO MATRIMONII from the defendant Harry J. Nichols, and it is further ordered and decreed that the defendant, Harry J. Nichols, pay to the plaintiff, Minnie E. Nichols, the sum of Eighteen (\$18.00) Dollars per month, payable monthly, as permanent alimony, accounting from the date of this decree, and that the defendant pay the costs of these proceedings.
