Report of sales of real estate.

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The petition and report of sales made by Robert E. Clapp, Jr., and H. Kieffer DeLauter, Trustees appointed in the above cause to make sale of the real estate mentioned therein.

Your petitioners after filing their duly approved bond and after complying with all other prerequisites of law and the decree passed in the above cause, gave notice of the time, place manner and terms of sale, by advertisement in the Frederick Post, a News Paper published in said Frederick County, once a week for three successive weeks prior to the day of sale, as appears from reference to the Printer's Certificate herewith filed and marked "Exhibit A".
