in the premises;

(1) That a decree may be passed for the sale of said real estate and that the proceeds may be distributed amongst the parties according to their interest therein.

(2) That a trustee or trustees may be appointed to make said sale and distribution.

(3) That your petitioners may have such other and further releif as the nature as their cause may require.

And may it please your Honors to grant unto your complainant the writ of sub poena directed to the said Anna Grossnickle Clay Grossnickle, Della Clark, Harry Clark, Dale Morgan, and Lottie Morgan, all residents of Frederick County, Maryland, and to May Hauver of Washington County, Maryland, all adults and to Joseph Shepley, the infant son of Ethel Shepley deceased and Foster Shepley residing at Myersville, in said Frederick County, Maryland: and also the order of publication against Grace Beachley and Raymond Beachley, her husband, non-residents or the State of Maryland and now residing in the State of Pennsylvania, in the usual form commanding them and each of them to be and appear in this court on some certain day to be named in said writ and said order of publication and to answer this bill of compalint and to abide by and perform such decrees as may be passed therein. and as in duty bound.
