TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition and Report of Sale of C. Albert Gilson, Trustee appointed to execute the Power of Sale contained in a mortgage from A. Atlee Radcliff to the Domestic Building Association of Frederick County, a body corporate, respectfully represents unto your Honorable Court:

FIRST: That pursuant to a Petition filed in your Honorable Court in the above entitled cause on April 12, 1939, wherein your Petitioner alleged a default having occurred in a mortgage from A. Atlee Radcliff to the Domestic Building Association, your Honorable Court, on said date, signed its order appointing C. Albert Gilson Trustee to execute the power of sale contained in said mortgage as fully described in said Petition, and pursuant to said Order your Petitioner gave bond to the State of Maryland in the penalty of \$14,000.00, which said bond was approved by the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, and after advertising said property for more than twenty days prior to the sale date, as provided by said mortgage, by public notice in the Frederick News, a newspaper printed and published in Frederick County, of the time, place, manner and terms of sale, a certificate of publication being filed herewith marked Exhibit No. 1 to this Petition and Report, your Petitioner attended at the Court House Door in Frederick City, Maryland, on Saturday, May 27, 1939, at the hour of eleven o'clock, a. m. it being the time and place mentioned in said advertisement of sale, and then and there offered at public sale all that parcel of land mentioned in said mortgage and more particularly described as follows:
