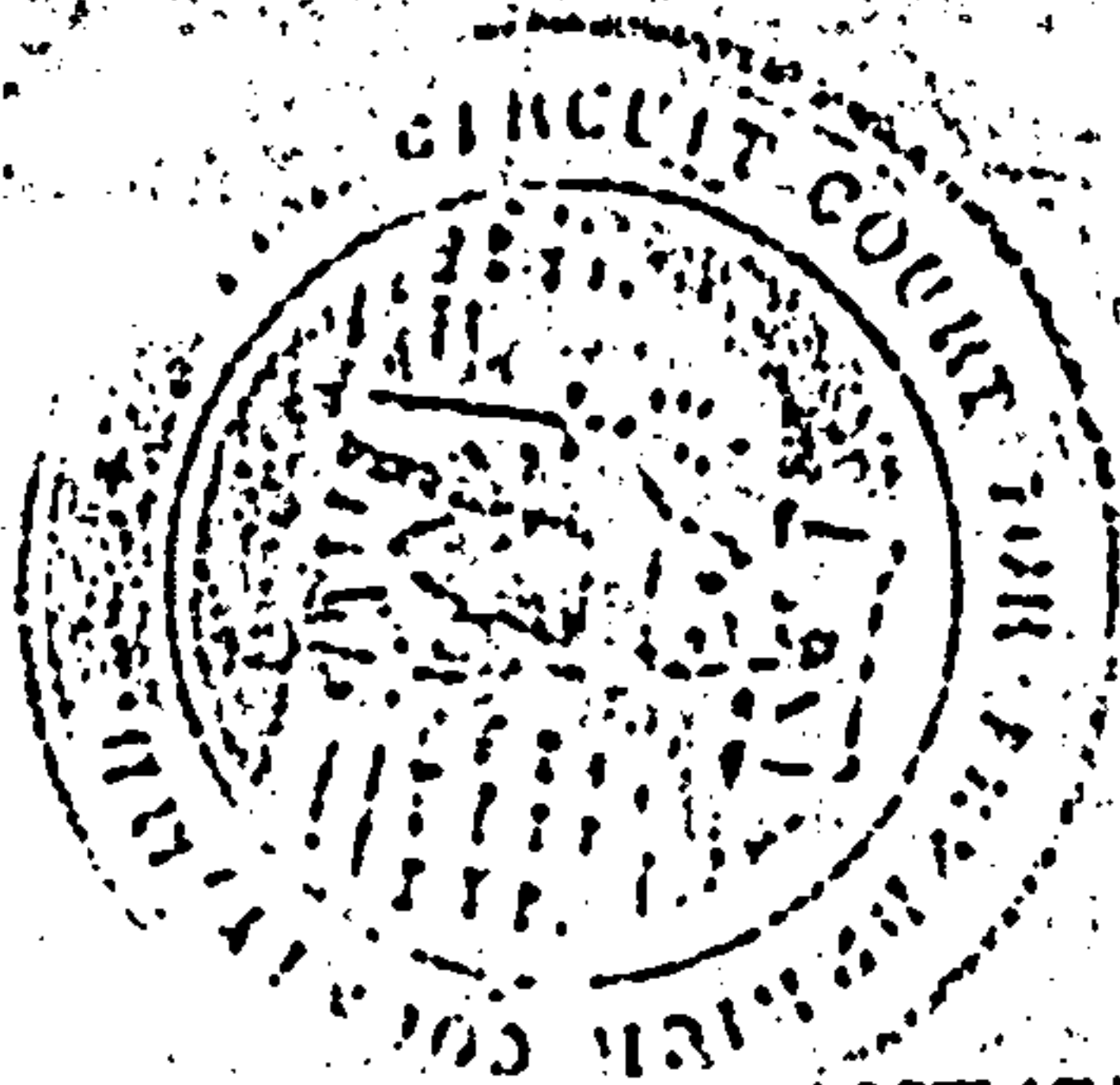
GREETING:
