

FOURTH: That there is filed herewith a statement signed by James H. Falk, County Treasurer as aforesaid, showing the amount necessary for the redemption of the said property and which said statement is marked Complainants' Exhibit Two, and is prayed to be taken as a part hereof.

FIFTH: That the said Harry K. Beachley departed from this life prior to the aforementioned sale, and that the last known address of the said Frank C. Beachley is Hagerstown, Maryland.
TO THE END THEREFORE:

1. That a final Decree may be passed by your Honorable Court, foreclosing all rights of redemption of the Defendants herein, in and to the property herein referred to, and that the County Treasurer for Frederick County, Maryland, be directed to prepare and execute a Deed, in fee simple, unto John T. Carey and Eva V. Carey, his wife, the Complainants herein, upon the payment by them in full, the purchase money of the property, together with all taxes, interest and penalties thereon accruing, subsequent to the date of sale.

2. And for such other and further relief as the nature of this cause may require.

May it please your Honors to grant unto your Complainants the Order of Publication giving notice to all persons, known and unknown, and whether residents or non-residents of the State of Maryland, having or claiming to have any interest in said property located in Petersville District, in said Frederick County, Maryland, described as Lots Number 88, 104 and 109 in New Addition, Brunswick, Maryland, assessed in the name of Harry K. Beachley and Frank C. Beachley, of the object and substance of this proceeding, and warning them to be and appear in this Court, in person or by Solicitor, on or before a certain day to be named therein, not less than sixty (60) days from the time of the filing of this Bill of Complaint, and answer said Bill of Complaint or redeem the property on or before a certain day named therein and warning him that upon
