- Q. And the properties as described in the Bill of Complaint, and the copies of deeds filed as Exhibits in this proceeding, correctly describe the properties.
- A. Yes, sir, they correctly describe the properties.
- Q. In your opinion is it possible to divide the properties among the parties - are these land mentioned in these proceedings and the exhibits filed therein, susceptible of partition or division without loss or injury to the parties entitled thereto.
- A. No, sir. They can not be divided in kind.
- Q. In order to make a fair and equitable division of the interests it will be necessary for the real estate to be sold, and the proceeds thereof divided among the parties hereto according to their several interests?
- A. Yes, sir.
- Q. Is it your request that the properties be sold under Court jurisdiction, and the proceeds divided among the persons entitled?
- A. Yes, sir.

To the general interrogatory. Nothing further.
