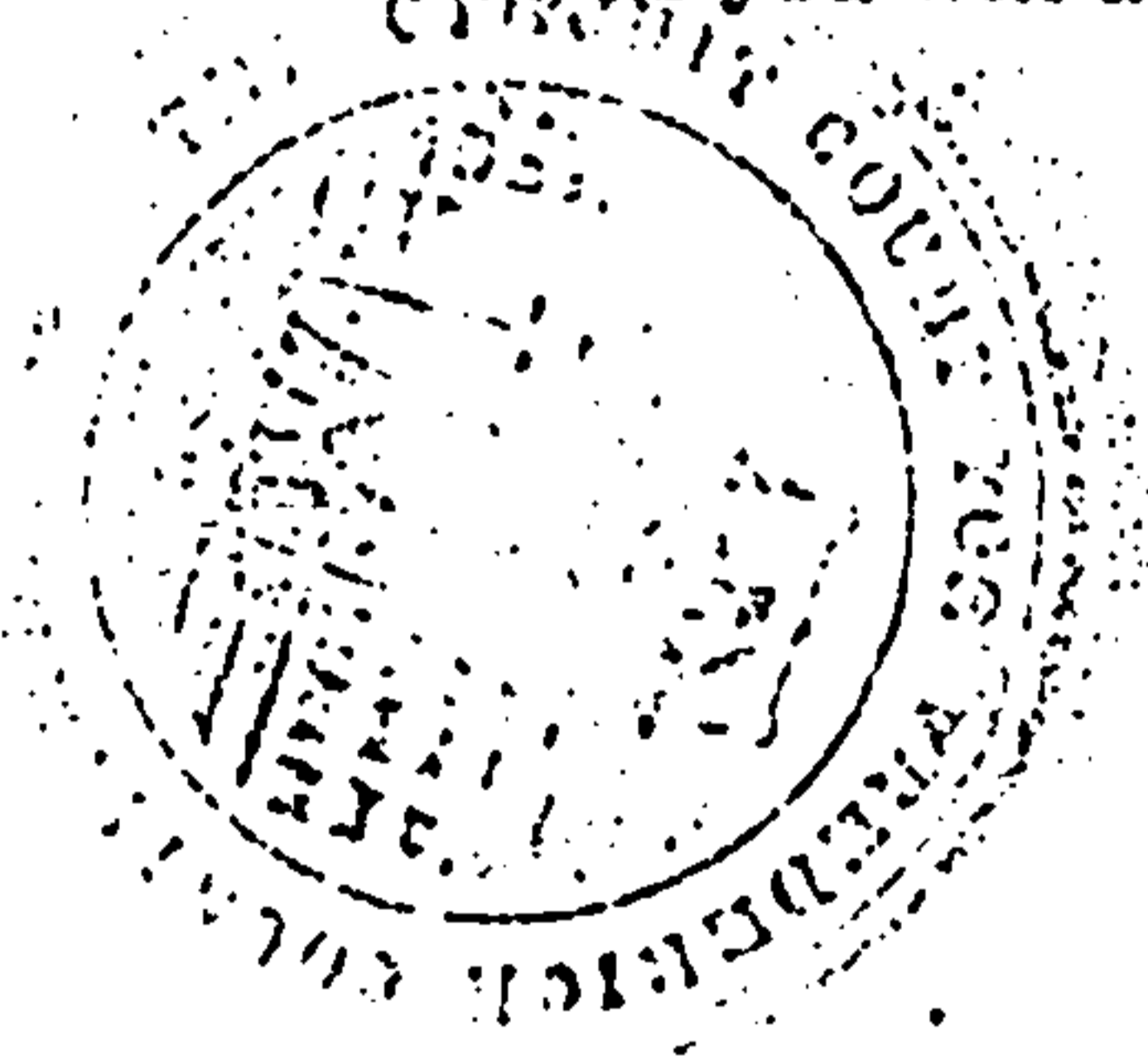
GREETING:
