1. That they admit the allegations of said Bill of Complaint and consent to the passage of a decree as prayed for in said Bill of Complaint.

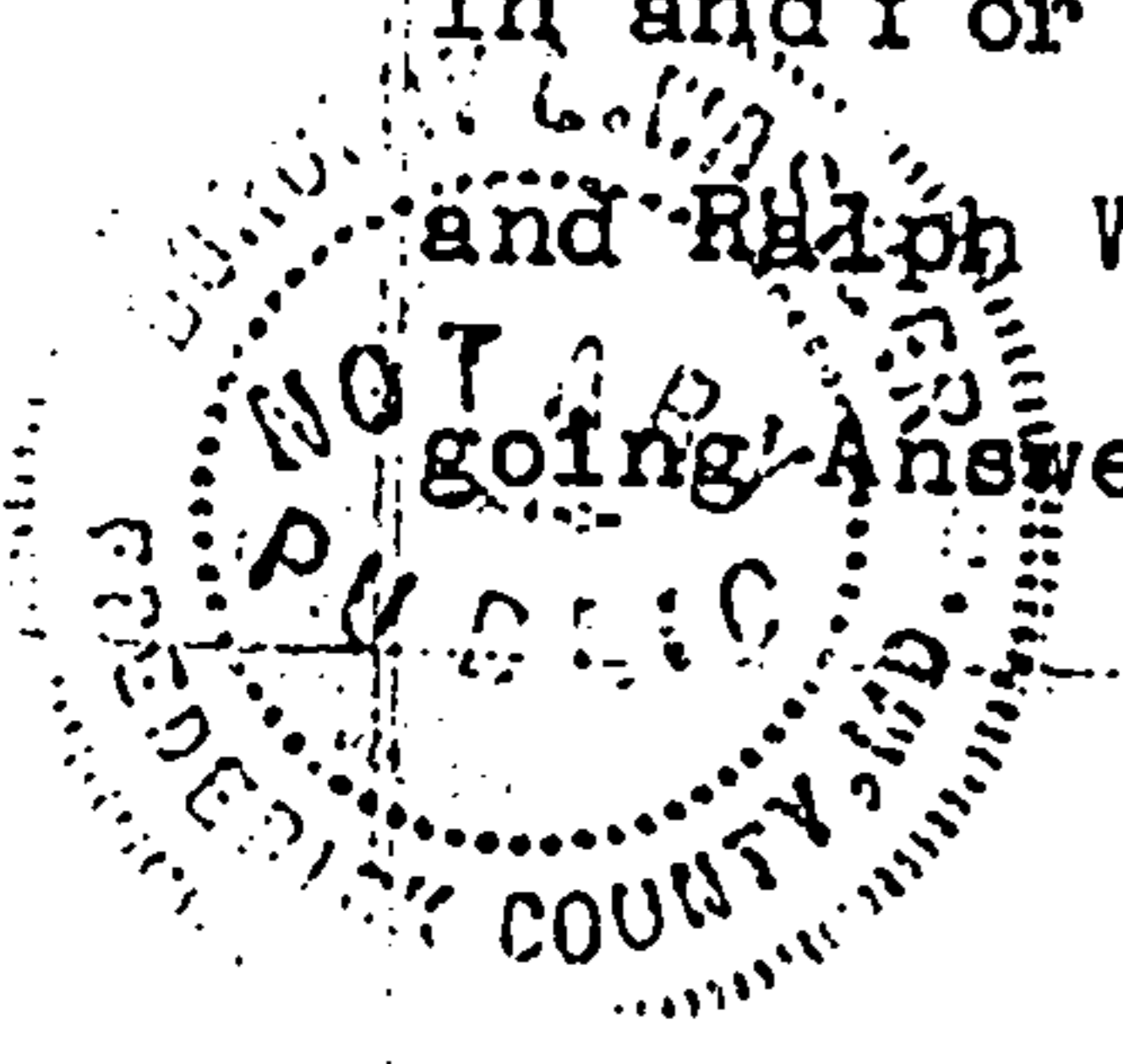
And having answered fully said bill, your respondents pray to be hence dismissed with their reasonable costs.
