

TO THE END, THEREFORE,

1. That a Decree may be passed by your Honorable Court appointing a Trustee and directing the sale of the real estate described in the foregoing Bill of Complaint, and that the net proceeds of said sale may be distributed among the parties entitled thereto.

2. And for such other and further relief as the nature of the case may require.

May it please your Honors to grant unto your Complainants an Order of Publication, giving notice to the said Robert M. McIntyre and Nellie McIntyre, his wife, both of whom are non-residents of the State of Maryland, of the substance and object of this Bill, and warning them and each of them to appear in this Court, in person or by Solicitor, on or before a certain day to answer the premises and show cause, if any they have, why a decree ought not to pass as prayed.
