FIFTH: That there is filed herewith a statement signed by James H. Falk, County Treasurer as aforesaid, showing the amount necessary for redemption of the said property, which statement is filed herewith as Exhibit No. 2 and which it is prayed may be taken and considered as a part hereof.

SIXTH: That the said Ernest L. Main and Ethel V. Main are residents of Frederick County, Maryland.

TO THE END, THEREFORE,

That a final decree may be passed by your Honorable Court foreclosing all rights of redemption of the said defendants therein, in and to the above mentioned property, and that James H. Falk, County Treasurer of Frederick County be directed to prepare and execute a deed in fee simple unto The Mayor and Council of Brunswick, a body corporate, the Complainant herein, upon payment by it of the purchase price of the property in full, together with all taxes, interest and penalties thereon accruing to the date of sale.

And for such other and further relief as the nature and equity of the case may require.

AND IT PLEASE YOUR HONORS to grant unto the Complainant herein, an Order of Publication, giving notice to all persons known and unknown, and whether residents or non-residents of the State of Maryland, having or claiming to have any interest in the property located at Nos. 11, 13, and 14 on Park Avenue, Brunswick, Maryland, with the improvements thereon, assessed in the names of Ernest L. Main and Ethel V. Main, commanding them and each of them, to appear in this Court on or before a certain day to be named therein not less than sixty days from the date of filing of this Bill of Complaint, and answer said Bill of Complaint or redeem the property, and warning them, and each of them, that upon their failure to do so a final decree will be rendered foreclosing all rights of redemption in the said property; and also that a writ of subpoena be issued directed to the said James H. Falk, County Treasurer for Frederick County, Maryland, said Ernest L. Main and Ethel V. Main, Brunswick, Maryland, commanding them, and each of them, to be and appear in person or by solicitor on or before a certain day to be named therein, not less than sixty days from

the filing of this Bill of Complaint, and answer said Bill of Complaint, or show cause, if any they have, why a decree should not be passed as prayed.
