

FIFTH: That since the remarriage of your petitioner, Pauline S. Sanbower, she is residing in Loudoun County, Virginia and is desirous of disposing of her interest in the above described real estate.

SIXTH: That the above described real estate is not susceptible of partition without doing great damage to the interest of all the parties hereto; that your petitioner believes that it would be to her best interest and to the best interest of the aforesaid infant children to sell the above described real estate at public sale and reinvest the aforesaid infant childrens' share of the proceeds derived therefrom in some manner approved by this Honorable Court.

TO THE END, WHEREFORE; your petitioner prays:

1. That this Honorable Court pass a decree for the sale of the above described real estate.
2. That a Trustee may be appointed to make such sale and distribution as this Court may direct.
3. That this Court appoint a guardian ~~ad litem~~ for the purpose of answering this petition and doing such other things as may be necessary for the proper protection of the interests of the infant children, Peggy Elizabeth Fogle Parker and Marlin Douglas Fogle.
4. And for such other and further relief as the nature of her cause may require.
