MRS. PAULINE S. SANBOWER, being of lawful age, having first been duly sworn, deposes and says:

By Mr. Glass:

Q. State your name to the Court, please.

A Pauline S. Sanbower.

Q Mrs. Sanbower, you were formerly Pauline S. Fogle, the widow of Archie T. Fogle, deceased?

A Yes, I was.

Q When did Mr. Fogle die, Mrs. Sanbower?

A December 31, 1950.

Q Did he own any real estate at the time of his death in his name alone?

A Yes, he owned our home in Lewistown.

Q Who did he leave as his heirs, Mrs. Sanbower?

A There was myself and my two children, Peggy Fogle, who was the adopted daughter of Archie, and our son, Marlin Douglas Fogle, and he had two adult children by a former marriage, Mrs. Bernice Fogle Haugh and Donald E. Fogle.

Q Mrs. Sanbower, subsequent to Mr. Fogle's death, did you purchase the interest of the two adult children in this property? I refer to the interest of Bernice F. Haugh and the interest of Donald E. Haugh.

A Yes, I did. I believe that the property was deeded to me in the month of April, 1951.

Q Has your daughter, Peggy, married since Mr. Fogle's death?

A Yes, she is married to Charles Parker. Mr. Parker is in the service and they are now living in the State of North Carolina.

Q How old is she at the present time?

A She is 20 years of age.

Q Have you remarried since Mr. Fogle's death?

A Yes, I have.

Q Would you state when and to whom you were married?

A I was married on the 8th day of August of this year in Lewistown to Henry Sanbower.

Q And where are you living at the present time?

A We are living on a farm near Lovettsville, Va.

Q Is your younger son, Marlin Douglas Fogle, living there with you?

A Yes, he is.
