

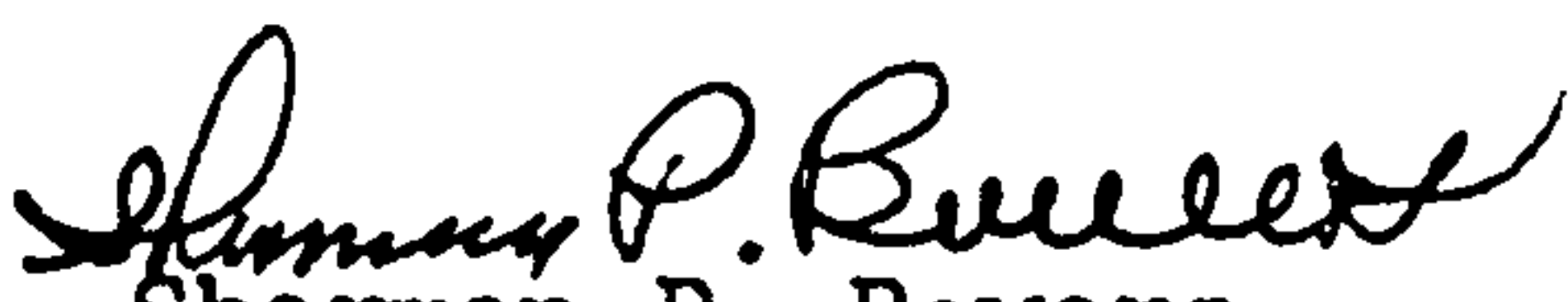
IN THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR
FREDERICK COUNTY, MARYLAND, IN EQUITY.No. 16696 Equity.

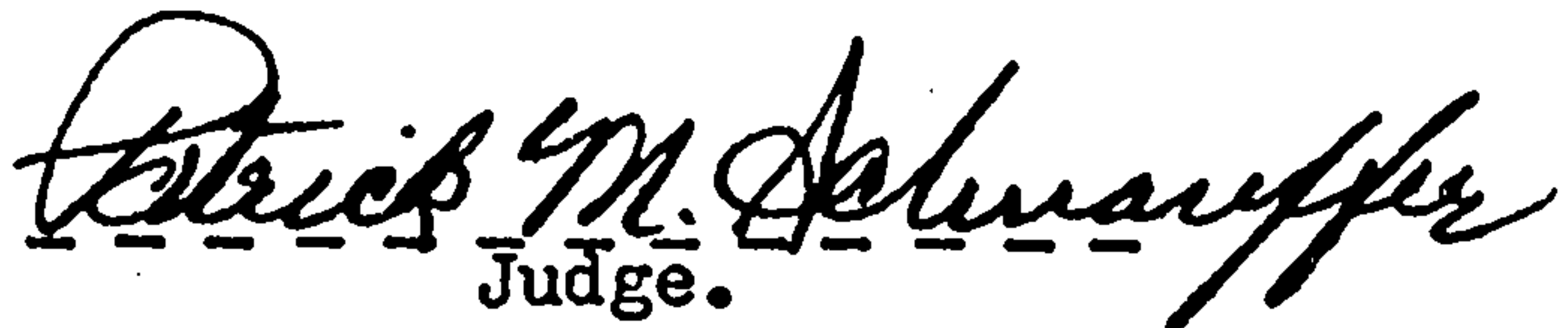
Augustus C. Tyeryar and Catherine E. Tyeryar, his wife,
vs. James H. Falk, Collector of Taxes for Frederick County, Md.,
Grayson L. De Grange, Catherine L. De Grange, his wife, now di-
vorced, Samuel T. Fleming and Annie S. Fleming, his wife, ~~Edward~~
~~Fleming~~, and ~~unknown~~ owners of properties, 5-acre parcel, New
Market District, Frederick County, Md., assessed in the names
of Grayson L. De Grange and Catherine L. De Grange, his wife,
and lot 50 x 150 feet, Ridgeville Heights, Woodville District,
Frederick County, Md., assessed in the names of Samuel T. Fleming
and Annie S. Fleming, his wife, and all persons having or claiming
to have any interest in said properties.

The object of these proceedings is to secure the foreclosure
of all rights or redemption in the following properties, to wit:-
5-acre parcel, in New Market District, Frederick Co., Md., deed
from The Westport Paving Brick Company to Grayson L. De Grange and
Catherine L. De Grange, his wife, and recorded among the Land Re-
cords of Frederick County, and lot 50 x 150 feet, in Ridgeville
Heights, in Woodville Election District, Frederick Co., Md., deed
from Langdon S. Day, widower, to Samuel T. Fleming and Annis
S. Fleming, his wife, dated August 25, 1924, Lib. 350, fol. 136,
one of Land Records of Frederick County.

The Bill states, among other things, that the amounts
necessary for redemption have not been paid, although more than
a year and a day from the date of sale has expired.

It is thereupon, this 19th day of August, 1949, by the
Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland, in Equity, ORDERED
that notice be given by the insertion of a copy of this order in
some newspaper having a general circulation in Frederick County,
Maryland, once a week for four successive weeks, warning all
persons interested in the said property to be and appear in this
Court by the 22nd day of October, 1949, and redeem the property
or properties mentioned herein and answer the Bill of Complaint,
or thereafter a final decree will be rendered foreclosing all rights
of redemption in the properties, and vesting fee simple title in
the complainants, free and clear of all encumbrances.
