The above cause standing ready for a hearing, and being submitted, the Bill, Answers, Exhibits, testimony and agreement of sale, and all other proceedings were by the Court read and considered.

It is thereupon, this 18th day of October, in the year 1950, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, as a Court of Equity, and by the authority of said Court, ADJUDGED, ORDERED and DECREED, that the real estate, to wit, No. 232 South Market Street, in Frederick City, Maryland, mentioned in these proceedings be sold and conveyed unto Harry M.
