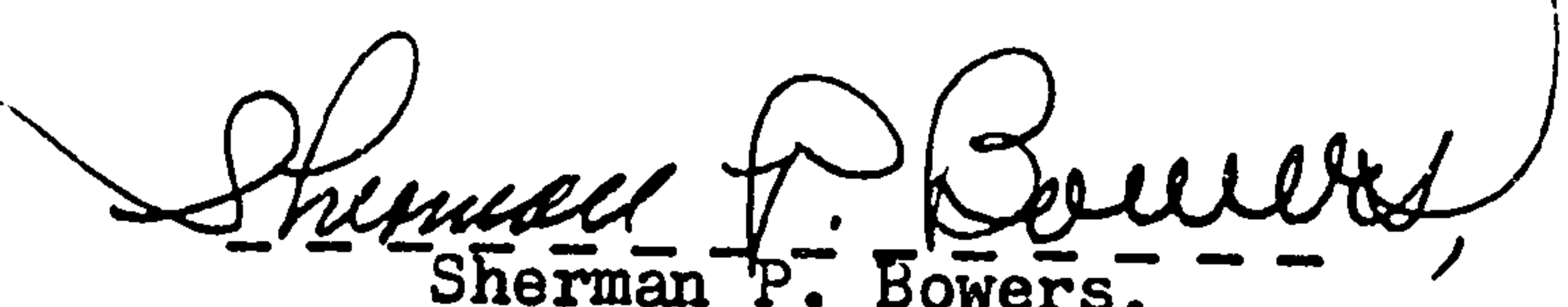


foreclosing all rights of redemption of the Defendants in and to the properties herein mentioned and described, and that the County Treasurer, Collector of Taxes for the State of Maryland, and the County of Frederick, Maryland, may be directed to prepare and execute a deed to the said Elmer B. Funk and Ruth V. Funk, his wife, for the said property, the Plaintiffs herein, and the holders of the Certificate of Sale, in fee simple, upon payment to the Collector of the balance of the purchase price of the property, together with all taxes and interest and penalties thereon accruing subsequent to the date of sale.

(b) And for such other and further relief as the nature of this cause may require.

(c) And may it please your Honors to grant unto these Complainants the writ of subpoena directed to the said James H. Falk, County Treasurer, Collector of Taxes for the State of Maryland, and all of the other Defendants mentioned as residents of the State of Maryland, and the Order of Publication against any possible non-resident heirs and/or of the one-acre tract aforesaid, and all persons having or claiming to have any interest in said property, warning said Defendants and all persons having or claiming to have an interest in said property to be and appear in this Court and answer the Bill of Complaint or to redeem the property on or before a certain day to be named in the said subpoenas and in the Order of Publication, and in case of failure to do so, a final decree will be rendered foreclosing all rights of redemption in the property.
