

TO THE END THEREFORE:


1. That a final Decree may be passed by your Honorable Court, foreclosing all rights of redemption of the Defendants herein, in and to the property herein referred to, and that the County Treasurer for Frederick County, Maryland, be directed to prepare and execute a Deed, in fee simple, unto Sterling Roberts, the Complainant herein, upon the payment by him in full, the purchase money of the property, together with all taxes, interest and penalties thereon accruing, subsequent to the date of sale.

2. And for such other and further relief as the nature of this cause may require.

May it please your Honors to grant unto your Complainant the Order of publication giving notice to all persons, known and unknown, and whether residents or non-residents of the State of Maryland, having or claiming to have any interest in said property located in Woodville District, in said Frederick County, Maryland, described as 11 acres of land, more or less, and the improvements thereon, assessed in the name of Archie Dotson, of the object and substance of this proceeding, and warning him, to be and appear in this Court, in person or by solicitor, on or before a certain day, to be named therein, not less than sixty (60) days from the time of the filing of this Bill of Complaint, and answer said Bill of Complaint or redeem the property on or before a certain day named therein and warning him that upon his failure to do so, a final Decree will be rendered foreclosing all rights of redemption in said property.

And also that the writ of Subpoena be issued, directed to the said James H. Falk, County Treasurer for Frederick County, Maryland, commanding him to be and appear either in person or by solicitor, in this Court, on or before a certain day to be named therein, not less than sixty (60) days from the time of the filing of this Bill of Complaint and answer said Bill of Complaint or show cause, if any he has, why a Decree ought not be passed as prayed.
