ORDER OF PUBLICATION

The object of this proceeding is to secure the foreclosure of all rights of redemption in the following property located in the Woodville District, Frederick County, Maryland, sold by the Collector of Taxes for the County of Frederick and the State of Maryland, to the Plaintiff in this proceeding: It being all that property located in Woodville District, Frederick County, Maryland, described as eleven (11) acres of land, more or less, and assessed to Archie Dotson.

The bill states, among other things, that the amounts necessary for redemption have not been paid, although more than a year and a day from the date of sale has expired. It is thereupon this 17th day of March by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, in Equity, ORDERED that notice be given by the insertion of a copy of this Order in some newspaper having a general circulation in Frederick County once a week for four successive weeks, warning all persons, known and unknown, residents and non-residents of the State of Maryland, interested in the said property to be and appear in this Court by the 30th day of May 1950, and redeem the property located in the Woodville District, described as eleven (11) acres of land, more or less, and assessed to Archie Dotson, and answer the bill or thereafter a final Decree will be rendered foreclosing all rights of redemption in the property, and vesting in the Plaintiff a title, free and clear of all encumbrances.
