

FINAL DECREE

Falk, County Treasurer for Frederick County, Maryland, be and he is hereby directed to execute a Deed, in fee simple, to Sterling Roberts, the Plaintiff in these proceedings and the holder of the Certificate of Sale, upon payment to the said James H. Falk, County Treasurer for Frederick County, Maryland, of the balance of the purchase price due on account of said property, together with all taxes and interest and penalties thereon accruing subsequent to the date of sale on April 12, 1948.
