To the Honorable, the Judges of said Court:

The Bill of Complaint of H. Walton White and Tillie H. White, his wife, and Isaac C. White and Mary M. White, his wife, respectfully represents unto your Honors:

1- That a certain Ellen M. White, late of Frederick County, Maryland, deceased, was in her lifetime seized and possessed of a lot or parcel of land situated, lying and being in Thurmont, Frederick County, Maryland, containing approximately two acres of land, and improved with a large frame dwelling house, and being the same parcel of land which was conveyed to Mary I. White and Ellen M. White, her sister, as joint tenants, by deed from William M. Leatherman and Mabel Leatherman, his wife, dated on the 22nd day of January, 1907, and recorded in Liber S.T.H. No. 278, Folio 182, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, Maryland, a certified copy of which said deed is herewith filed and marked Exhibit "No. 1;" and also all that lot or parcel of land which was conveyed to Mary I. White and Ellen M. White, as joint tenants, by deed from the Trustees of the United Brethren Church located at Thurmont, dated on the 27th day of November, in the year 1907, and recorded in Liber S.T.H. No. 282, Folio 93, etc., one of said Land Records, a certified copy of which said deed is herewith filed and marked Exhibit "No. 2;" and it is prayed that both of said Exhibits
