


commanding the said Defendant to be and appear in your Honorable Court on the first Monday of February, 1942, to answer the said petition, or to file any other defense which the said Defendant may have to the proceedings herein, within fifteen days after the aforementioned return day, but the said Charles Allen Seiss is still suffering from mental disability and thus is incompetent and unable to answer and defend the aforesaid suit for himself.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioners pray that your Honorable Court will pass an order appointing a guardian ad litem to appear and answer for the said Charles Allen Seiss, incompetent, in the proceedings heretofore filed in this cause.
