ORDER OF PUBLICATION

The object of this proceeding is to secure the foreclosure of all rights of redemption in the following described property located in Buckeystown District, Frederick County, Maryland, which was sold by James H. Falk, County Treasurer and collector of taxes for the County of Frederick and for the State of Maryland, to the Complainants in this proceeding, said property being all that real estate situate, lying and being near Point of Rocks in the County and State aforesaid, and being a lot of ground containing 1/4 of an acre, more or less, as fully described in deed of William H. Russell to Lydia Russell, dated August 15, 1889 and recorded in Liber W. I. P. No. 9, folio 414, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, Maryland, which said land is assessed to Lydia Russell.

The Bill states, among other things, that the amounts necessary for redemption have not been paid, although more than a year from the date of sale has expired.

It is thereupon this 22nd day of March, 1952, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, in Equity, ORDERED that notice be given by the insertion of a copy of this Order in some newspaper having a general circulation in Frederick County once a week for four suc-
