

"EXHIBIT "B"

I, J. Eugene Meadows, of Brunswick, Frederick County, Maryland, being of sound and disposing mind, memory and understanding, do hereby make, publish and declare this my last will and testament, in the manner and form following:

1. I will and direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid by my executrix as early after my decease as convenient.

2. I give and devise and bequeath all of my real and personal estate, wherever situated, to which I may be entitled at the time of my decease, unto my wife, Birdie Meadows, to be held by her during the term of her natural life, if she shall so long continue my widow, with full power to her, during her widowhood, to sell and convey, absolutely or by way of mortgage or lease, any or all of my estate, real and personal, and to re-invest the proceeds thereof in her own discretion, and from and after the death or marriage of my said wife, my estate is to go to and be equally divided among my children.

The provisions heretofore made for my said wife is to be in full satisfaction of all other interest in my real and personal estate, unless she shall marry again in which event she shall receive the same amount or interest in my estate to which she would have been entitled in case of my dying intestate.

And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my wife the said Birdie Meadows, to be the executrix of this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all former wills.
