

from or under them, or either of them; and the said trustee shall bring into this court the money arising from said sale, to be distributed under the direction of this court, after deducting the costs of this suit and such commission to the said trustee as this court shall think proper to allow in consideration of the skill, attention and fidelity wherewith he shall appear to have discharged his trust.

And at the time of advertising said sale the Trustee is directed to give notice to the Creditors of Trovilla W. Carlisle, deceased, to file their claims against said estate with the vouchers thereof, with the Clerk of this Court on or before the 19th day of September next.

And it is further ordered that the administratrices account to this Court for all money and property coming into their hands as administratrices.
