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2nd. And for such other and further relief as the nature of the case may require.

And may it please your Honors to grant unto your complainants the Writ of Subpoena directed to Hattie E. Porter and James W. Porter, her husband, W. All Saints Street, Frederick, Maryland, and William H. Roberts and Annie Roberts, his wife, of Libertytown, Maryland, notifying them of the object and substance of this Bill and commanding them to be and appear in your Honorable Court on some day certain to be named therein, to answer the premises and abide by and perform such Decree as may be passed.

And may it please your Honors to grant unto your Complainants an Order of Publication, giving notice to James A. Roberts and Mary Roberts, his wife, who reside at 235 S. Washington Street, Gettysburg, Pa., Robert R. Roberts and Treassa Roberts, his wife, who reside at 235 S. Washington Street, Gettysburg, Pa.; Philip L. Roberts and Mary . Roberts, his wife, who reside at 5670 Lawton Avenue, Detroit, Michigan, all of whom are non-residents of the State of Maryland, of the object and substance of this Bill, warning them and each of them to be and appear in your Honorable Court either in person or by solicitor, on or before a certain day to be named therein, to answer the premises and show cause, if any they have, why a Decree should not be passed as prayed.
