

Q And what property, if any, does she have?

A The property in Washington, 2228 Hall Street - a one-sixth interest I understand.

Q She has a one-third interest in one-half of this estate of that property?

A As far as I know.

Q And that comes from your father, who died?

A From my father and stepmother.

Q You don't know of any other property she might have?

A No, I don't.

Q If the Court should see fit to appoint you as Committee would you serve?

A Be glad to.

Q Do you have any idea of the value of that property off-hand; has there been an offer made?

A Yes, we signed the contract for \$15,000, but I contacted Mr. Quemby, who is the attorney of record, and he said there were several buyers who wanted the property badly, so there is a higher bid - \$15,500.00.

Q Be approximately \$15,000?

A Approximately \$15,000.

Q She would be entitled to one-sixth of \$15,000, less expenses of administration, and so on.
