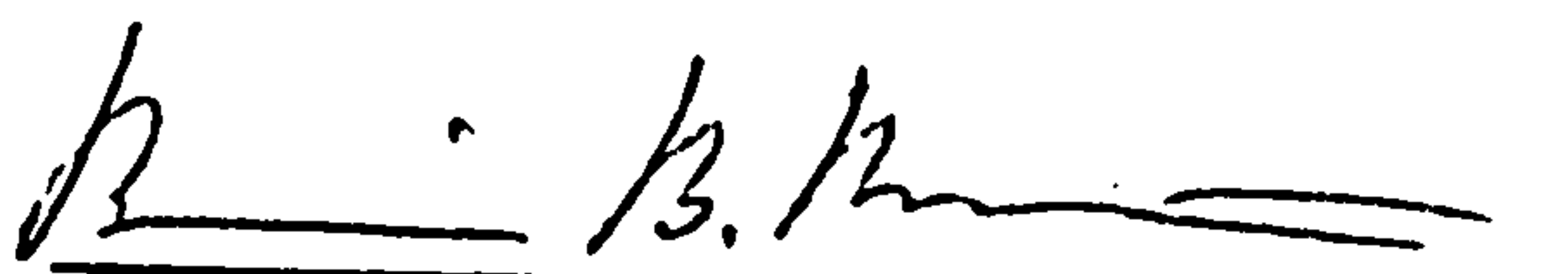

FOURTH: From the testimony of the real estate agent as well as that of the representative from the Fredericktown Savings Institution, your Petitioner believes and therefore avers that Fourteen Thousand Dollars (\$14,000.00) is the fair market value of the real estate owned by the incompetent and her husband as tenants by the entireties, and that the offer of said amount of the aforesaid Rays should be accepted.

WHEREFORE, YOUR PETITIONER prays that your Honorable Court may authorize him to join with Abraham Hamburger in the execution of said contract of sale on behalf of the incompetent Rebecca Hamburger, and for such other and further relief as the nature of the cause may require.

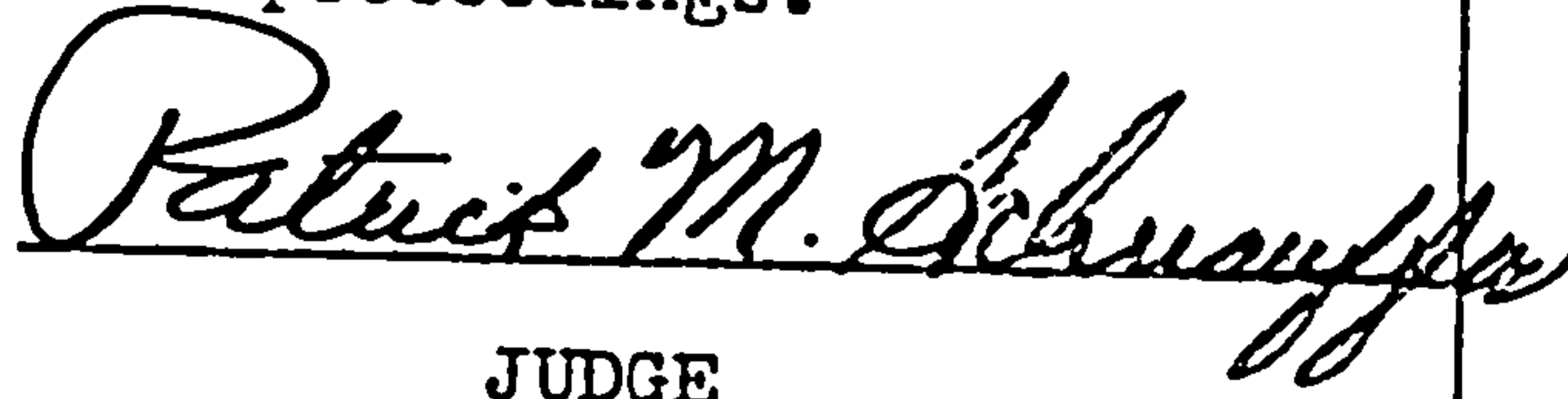
