TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition and Report of Sales of Charles McC. Mathias, Trustee in the above entitled cause, respectfully shows unto your Honors:

(1) That pursuant to the requirements of a Decree of your Honorable Court, dated the 21st day of April, 1941, the Trustee in this cause and in said decree named, gave bond to the State of Maryland in the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000), with the Globe Indemnity Company of New York, as corporate surety, which said bond was duly approved by the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, and filed as required by law.
