And as in duty bound, etc.

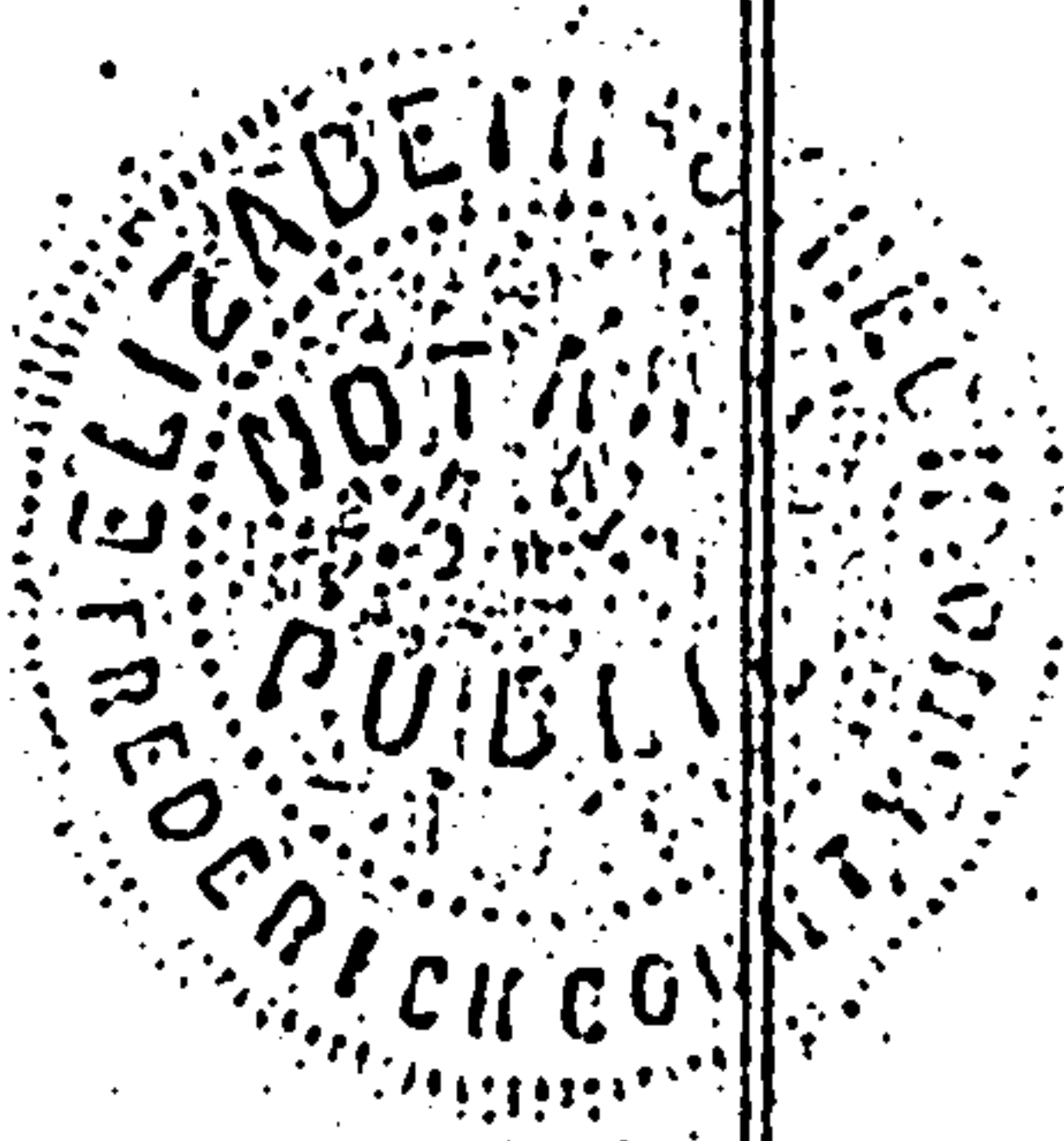
