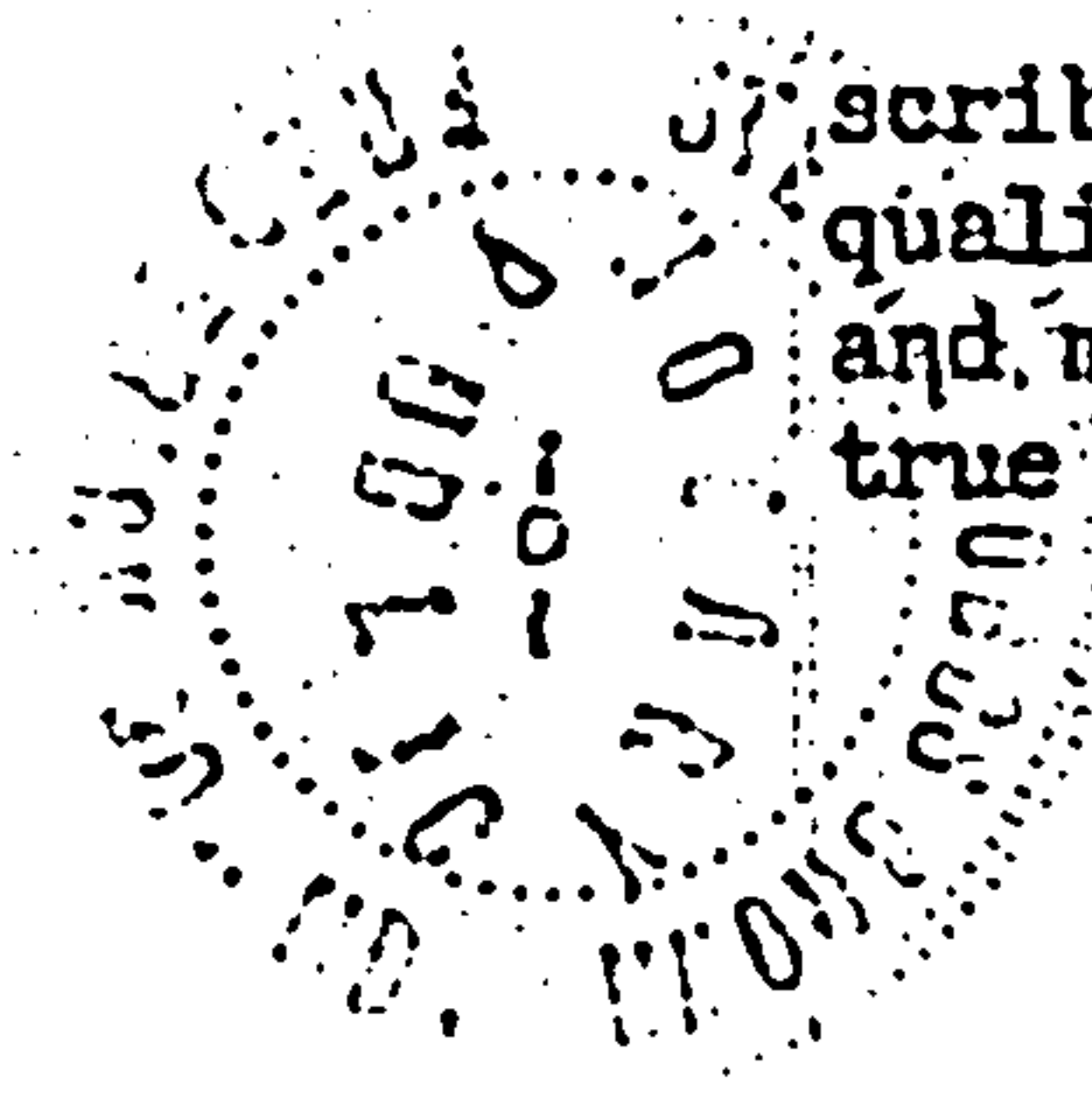

ORDER

The foregoing Petition and Affidavit having been presented to the Court and by the Court read and considered, it is thereupon this 19th day of April, 1956, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity and by the authority thereof, ADJUDGED, ORDERED AND DECREED that Charles L. Thompson, Committee in No. 17984 Equity issue a check in the sum of One Thousand Forty-seven Dollars and sixty-two cents, (\$1,047.62), from the funds deposited in his Committee account at the F&M-Citizens National Bank, unto Susie B. Culler, as and for her full share in the proceeds from the sale of No. 239 Washington Street, Frederick, Maryland.

And it is further ADJUDGED, ORDERED AND DECREED that the said Charles L. Thompson, Committee, be and he is hereby authorized to pay the Court costs and all other costs of these proceedings, that he pay the two aforementioned loans, with interest, unto Lydia Maple and F&M-Citizens National Bank, used to pay 1954 and 1955 taxes.

It is further ADJUDGED, ORDERED AND DECREED that the said Charles L. Thompson, Committee, be and he is hereby authorized to pay unto Stewart Hobbs Brown, Solicitor, from said funds the sum of Five Hundred Dollars as counsel fee for services rendered in this cause; that he pay unto himself, the sum of 10% of the receipts and expenditures, as commissions for services rendered as said Committee; such commissions shall not apply however to the proceeds realized from the sale of the real property known as No. 239 Washington Street, Frederick, Maryland.

It is further ADJUDGED, ORDERED AND DECREED that these proceedings be and they are hereby referred to the Court Auditor to state an Account.
