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ORDER OF PUBLICATION

The object of this proceeding is to secure the foreclosure of all rights of redemption in the following property located in Tuscarora District, in Frederick County, Maryland, sold by the Collector of Taxes for the County of Frederick and the State of Maryland, to the Plaintiffs in this proceeding, to-wit:

All that unimproved lot or parcel of land containing $1\frac{3}{4}$ acres, more or less, and assessed in the name of Elizabeth A. Leonard.

The Bill of Complaint states, among other things, that the amounts necessary for the redemption have not been paid, although more than a year and a day from the date of sale has expired.

It is thereupon, this 15th day of *December*, 1955, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity, and by the authority thereof, ORDERED that notice be given by the insertion of a copy of this ORDER in some newspaper having a general circulation in said Frederick County, once a week for four successive weeks, warning all persons, known and unknown, residents and non-residents of the State of Maryland, interested in said property to be and appear in this Court by the 16th day of *February*, 1956, and redeem the property located in Tuscarora District, in Frederick County, Maryland, and being an unimproved lot or parcel of land containing $1\frac{3}{4}$ acres, more or less, and assessed in the name of Elizabeth A. Leonard, and answer the Bill of Complaint, or thereafter a final decree will be rendered foreclosing all rights of redemption in the property, and vesting in the Complainants a title, free and clear of all encumbrances.
