- A I think there is a nephew. I don't know what his last name is - his name of course would be Miller, but I don't know what his first name is. He was the son of George David Miller, who is dead.
 - Q George David Miller was a brother of J. Marshall Miller?
 - A Yes.
 - Q And this is his son?
 - A Yes.
 - Q And is the nephew living or dead?
- A As far as I know I think he is. We haven t checked up on that, but I imagine he is living.
 - Q Do you know where he is living?
 - A I think it is Mount Alto, Pennsylvania.
 - MR. KOEFOED, a witness produced on the part of the Petitioners, being first duly sworn, deposes and says:

By Mr. DeLauter:

- Q You are the husband of Mrs. Koefoed, who has just testified?
- Yes.
- Do you know J. Marshall Miller?
- A I have known him for 40 years.
- Q And you visited in the home?
- Yes.
- Q And have you made a preliminary check-up of the assets?
- A When Virginia Miller died I was present when Mr. Miller's box was opened and we found nothing in there that belonged to Virginia Miller regarded of any value, nor of Mr. Miller's. Other than that it is his personal property and his home, consisting of furniture and what not, and automobile I understand he has in the garage, and his real estate. That is 731 North Market Street.
