

ORDER OF COURT?

Upon the foregoing petition of the Trustees in the above cause, their affidavits and the testimony taken in open Court, it is, this 11th day of April, 1956, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting in Equity, and by the authority thereof, adjudged, ordered and decreed that said Trustees, William H. Hicks and Naomi Miller Koefed, be and they are hereby authorized and directed to sell, at either public or private sale, the real estate of J. Marshall Miller, the incompetent in these proceedings, and mentioned in the foregoing petition, after such advertisement as is required by law in such cases and to report such sale to this Court for confirmation.

And it is further ordered by the authority aforesaid, that before said Trustees proceed to make such sale,, they shall file in the office of the Clerk of this Court, a good and sufficient bond, with surety or sureties to be approved by this Court or the Clerk thereof, in the usual form and in the penalty of Thirty Thousand dollars, if given with corporate surety, or in the penalty of Sixty Thousand dollars, if given with personal sureties, for the faithful performance of the trust reposed in them by this order, or that may be imposed in them by any future order of this Court in the premises.
