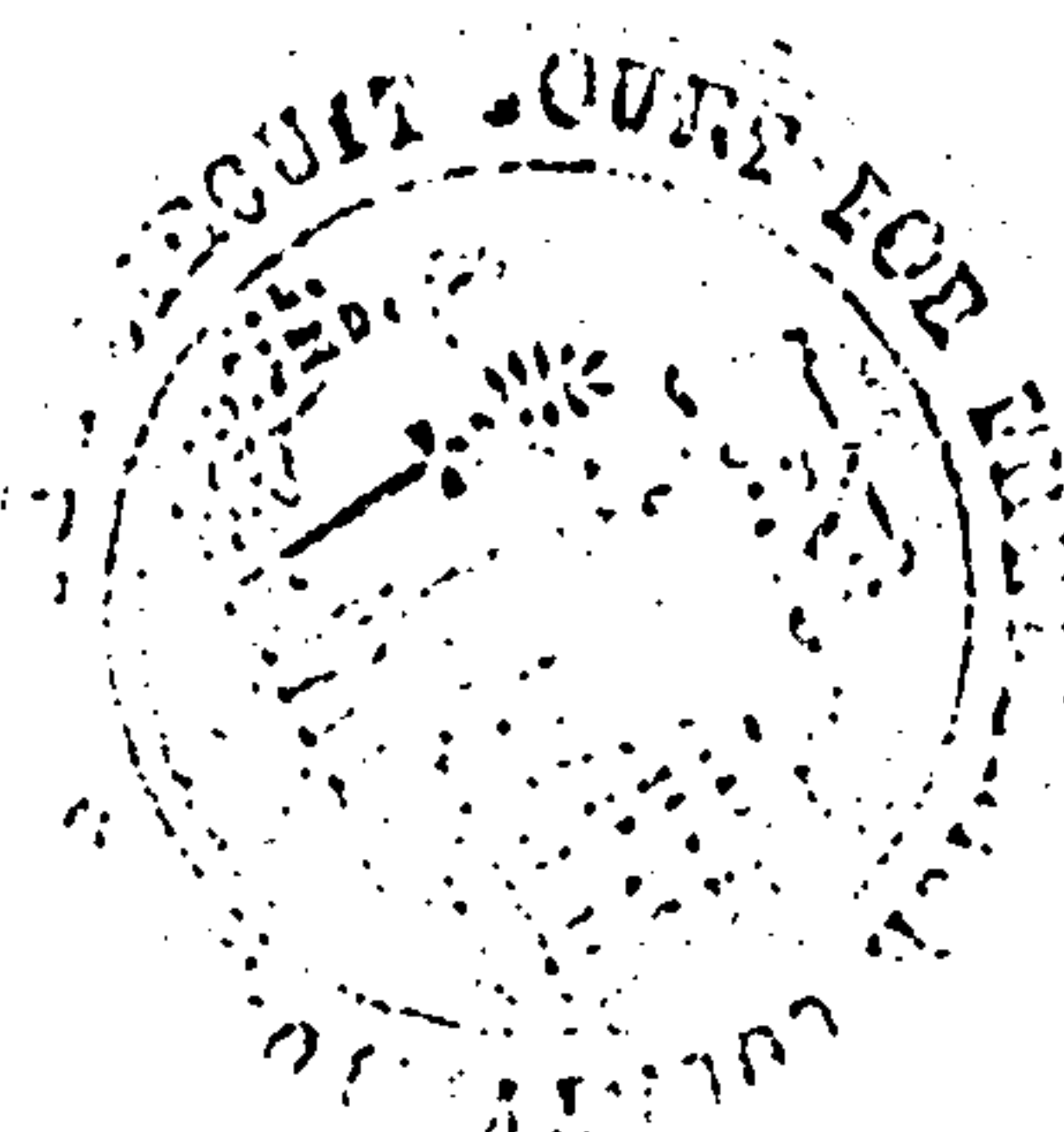
GREETING:
