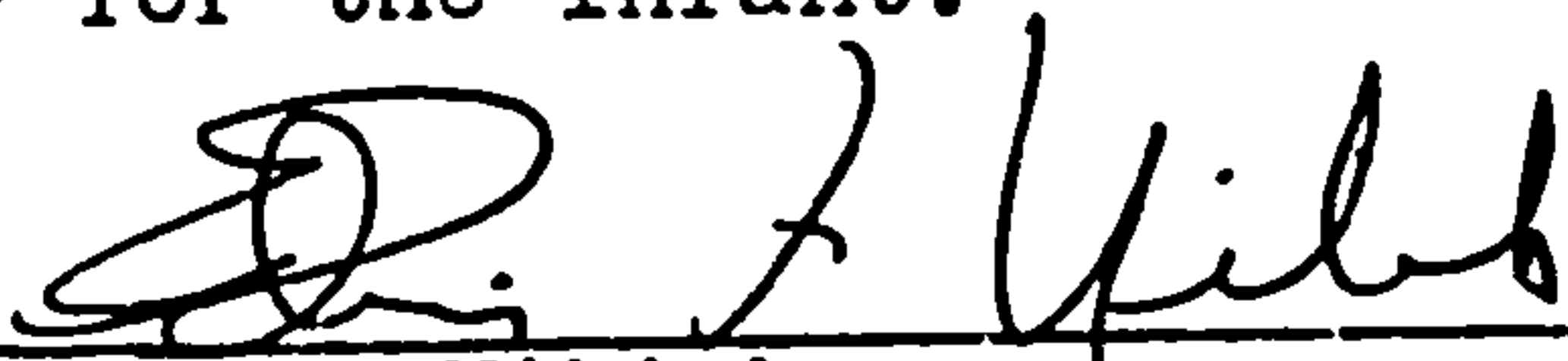
TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:
