

fuel oil fired hot water system. The first floor has a lobby and two other rooms and bath, and in addition to that there is an annex or a wing to the rear that has three rooms, a utility room. The second floor has four bedrooms, each with a lavatory and one bath, old type, to serve those four rooms. And then there is one back room which you enter from another stairway or off of the basement with bath, and a bath with a metal shower for that bath. I appraised the lot and improvements of this property at \$14,000.

335 North Market Street is the annex or the property on the west side of North Market Street. It has a frontage of $24\frac{1}{2}$ feet and a depth of 124, and this is a two-story brick building. That is, the major building. There is an annex with that also, or wing, on the first floor that runs back. That has three rooms, three bedrooms. The lot and improvements there I valued at \$11,500, and the personal property of 336, which is the hotel building I valued at \$525, and the personal property at 335, the hotel annex, at \$500.

Then there is a lot near Woodsboro, about $1\frac{1}{4}$ acres of unimproved land, I valued at \$75, and a 1941 Chrysler in running condition, \$100.

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
