TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition and Report of Sales of Real Estate made by John W. Myers and Evelyn M. Weddle, Committee, of the person and estate of Lillie R. Myers, in the above captioned cause, respectfully represents:

FIRST: That in pursuance of an Order of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity, passed in the above entitled cause, on the 1st day of August, 1957, the undersigned Committee, after filing their duly approved bond, gave notice of the time, place, manner and terms of sale, by advertising in the Frederick News, a newspaper published in Frederick County, once a week for three successive weeks prior to the date of sale, as appears from the Printer's Certificate, filed herewith as a part of this Petition, and marked "Exhibit A".
