And for such other and further relief as may be requisite.

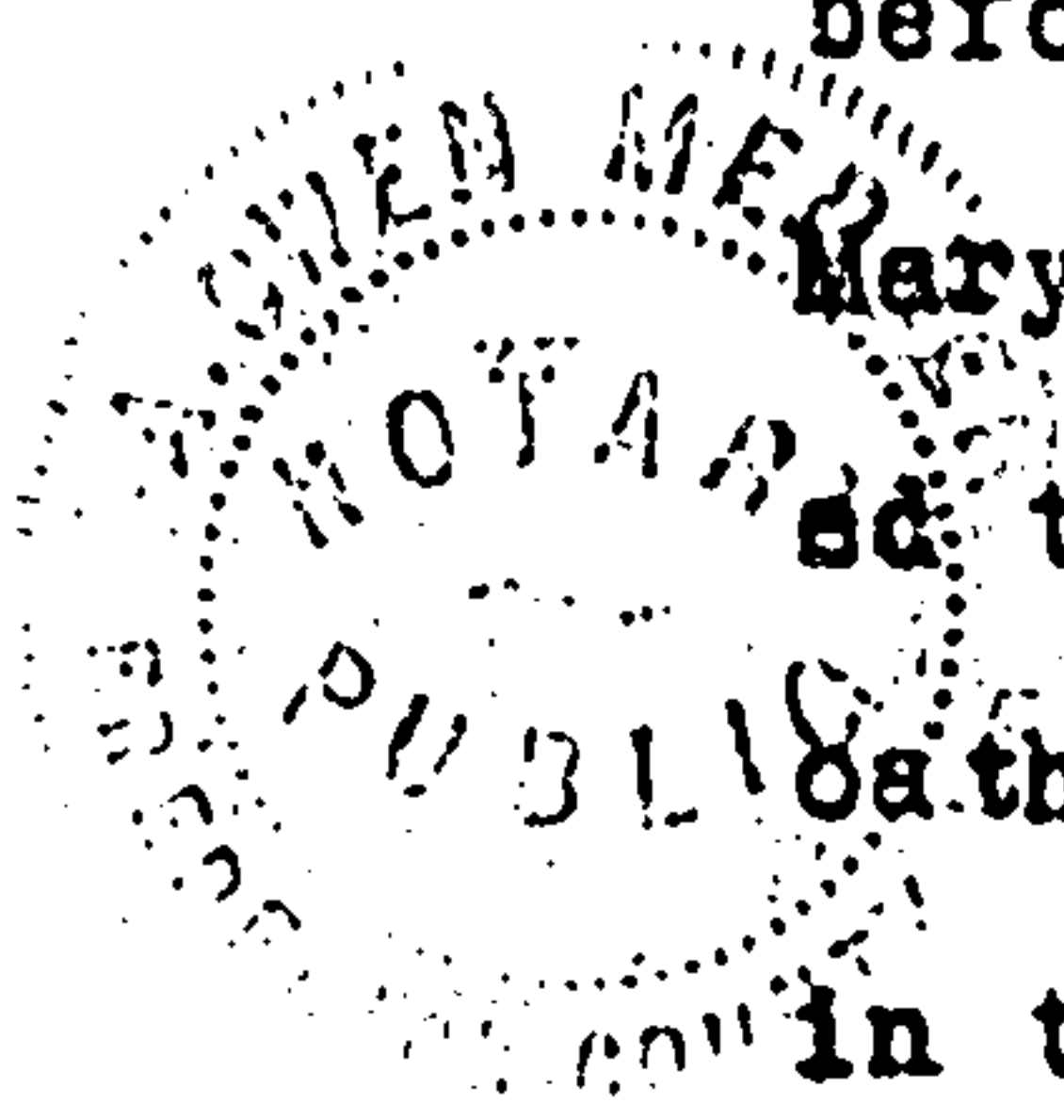
