

but if she should die leaving no children or child surviving her I then devise said undivided three fourths of said farm and ten acre wood lot to such of my lineal descendants as may be ^(then) living to be equally divided between them per stirpes that is to say to my daughter Susan Elizabeth and son S. Amos if living and if either or both be dead then to their children living.

It is my will and intention that the undivided three fourths interest in said farm and wood lot devised to my said ^{daughter} ~~son~~ Laura N. Clary for her life as aforesaid shall be in full of her share of my estate and ⁱⁿ lieu of a one third division at the valuation before directed, and if the same at the valuation before directed shall be ascertained to be in excess of the shares given to my other children, I do not intend that she shall be subjected to any abatement on account thereof.

It is my will and I do so direct that my daughter ~~Sara~~ Laura N. Clary or her husband shall have the right to purchase at any time during her lifetime and within ten years from my death the undivided one fourth interest in said farm and wood lot devised to my daughter Susan Elizabeth Englar at the valuation hereinbefore placed on said one fourth interest and upon my said daughter Laura paying to my said daughter Susan Elizabeth the said sum of sixteen hundred and thirty-one and 25/100 dollars within the time before named, she shall own said undivided one fourth interest in fee simple.
