Q What is Gladys' husband's name?

A Gladys' husband's name is Russell G. Kelbaugh. And one is named Garlan .

Q Garlan is the infant, is that right? A. Yes, he is under age.

Q Are there any children or heirs you know of?

A Not that I know of.

Q At the time of your brother's death what real estate did he own?

A He owned six lots out on that new development.

Q Catoctin Park? A. Yes.

Q I show you deed marked Exhibit No. 2 from G. Leicester Thomas, et al, dated November 5, 1937; will you tell the Court whether that describes the lots you mentioned that your brother owned?

A He sold three or four of these lots. There are four lots over there on B, I think 57 and 58, and 59 and 60 in Block G. I think that's the four lots there. Then there's two lots there in Block B.
