The above case standing ready for hearing and being submitted on the petition, exhibits and the testimony taken in open Court, it is thereupon this 4th day of August, 1953, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity, and by the authority thereof, ADJUDGED, ORDERED and DECREED, that Sarah V. Burall, be and she is hereby declared to be incompetent by reason of a mental disability, to manage her estate and that Walter E. Burall, residing at New Market, Maryland, be and he is hereby appointed Committee to take charge of and manage the property of the said Sarah V. Burall, and the course of his proceeding shall be as follows:

He shall first execute a bond to the State of Maryland with good and sufficient security, to be approved by this Court or the Clerk thereof, in the penalty of \$2,000.00 if corporate surety is given and \$4,000.00 if personal surety is given, conditioned that the said Walter E. Burall as Committee aforesaid will faithfully discharge his duties as such Committee of the said Sarah V. Burall and deliver up all of the property of the said Sarah V. Burall, whenever he may be required by the Order of the Court so to do;

He shall return to this Court an inventory specifically setting forth all property, real and personal belonging to the estate of the said Sarah V. Burall, and all cash in hand and in bank.

He shall render a full and particular account of all receipts of income and expenditures by him made for and on account of said estate once in each and every year, or oftener, if so required by the Court.
