This cause standing ready for hearing, having been submitted on petition of Alice I. Etzler, sister-in-law and next friend of Silas W. Etzler, an alleged incompetent; and it appearing to the Court that a copy of the petition and order nisi in this cause were duly served on the said Silas W. Etzler; and that the said alleged incompetent failed within the period prescribed by this Court to show cause why a committee or trustee should not be appointed to take charge of and manage the property of the said alleged incompetent, the proceedings were read and considered and testimony taken; and it appearing to the Court further that the said Silas W. Etzler is incompetent to take charge of and manage his property by reason of a mental disability.

It is thereupon this 6th day of March, 1957, ADJUDGED, ORDERED and DECREED by the Circuit Court for Frederick County in Equity that Richard E. Zimmerman
and Byron W. Thompson be and they are hereby appointed Trustees of the estate of Silas W. Etzler, an incompetent, with full power and authority under the jurisdiction of this Court to take charge of and manage the property of the said Silas W. Etzler, an incompetent, during the period of his incompetency; the Court retaining the power to revoke, modify or alter any decree hereunder at any time after appearance and answer for good cause shown.

And it is further ORDERED that said Committee shall first file in the Clerk's Office of this Court, a bond to the State of Maryland, executed by them, if with corporate surety, in the penalty of \$ 5,000.00 ^{or} ~~10,000.00~~ or if personal surety, in the penalty of \$ 10,000.00 ^{or} ~~10,000.00~~ to be approved by the Court, or the Clerk, thereof, conditioned for the faithful performance of the trust reposed in them by this decree, or which may be reposed in them by any future order, or decree in the premises.
