

the proceeds of the sale herein reported and from other monies which your Trustees have received in their appointed capacity.

NINTH: That your Trustees have received in addition to the receipts from the sale of the real estate herein reported, the sum of Eighteen Hundred Ninety-five Dollars and Sixty-one Cents (\$1895.61), which said sum your Petitioners have deposited in a savings account at Frederick Federal Savings and Loan Association, which said account is insured to the extent of the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) by the Federal Savings and Loan Insurance Corporation, an instrumentality of the United States Government, and that the current rate of dividend being paid by said Association is 3-1/2% per annum, and that dividends in the amount of Forty Dollars and Fifty-seven Cents (\$40.57) have been received by your Petitioners and credited on said account to date. Your Petitioners believe that Frederick Federal Savings and Loan Association is a safe and convenient place for the deposit of these funds and that the interest paid thereon exceeds that paid by other savings institutions in this area, and that the said Frederick Federal Savings and Loan Association should be approved as a depository for the funds already received by your Petitioners and the additional funds received from the sale of the real estate herein reported, less the proper expenses allowed by your Honorable Court, ought to be deposited in Frederick Federal Savings and Loan Association for the benefit of the estate of Silas W. Etzler, an incompetent, and to pay therefrom, from time to time, such monies as may be required for the maintenance and welfare of the said incompetent.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioners pray your Honorable Court to pass an order authorizing and directing your Petitioners to pay the necessary and usual expenses herein recited in connection with the sale of the real estate of the incompetent, including the usual commissions allowed to Trustees for the sale of real estate, In Equity, to pay all court costs to date incurred in this cause, to allow the said Petitioners an attorney's fee in the amount of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00), to compensate them for services rendered in this cause to date, to approve the deposit of all unexpended funds of the incompetent in an account at Frederick Federal Savings and Loan Association, and to make such disbursements therefrom as will be necessary for the welfare of the said incompetent.
