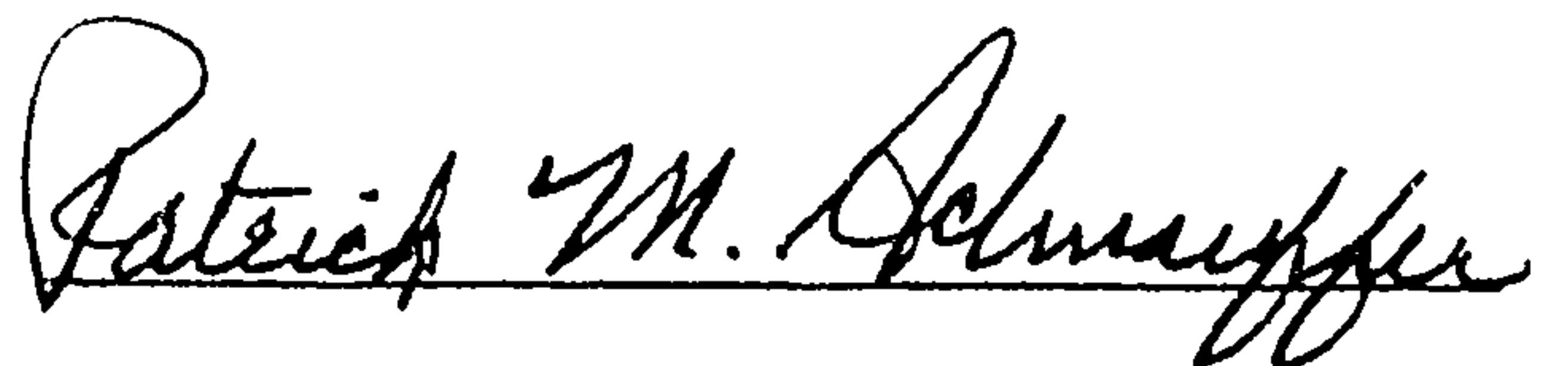

DECREE

The foregoing Petition and Report of Sale, Affidavit and Exhibits having been read and considered, it is thereupon, this 17th day of February 1958, ADJUDGED, ORDERED and DECREED that the matters therein reported be referred to the auditor to state an account subject to the usual exceptions, and that in addition to the usual allowance for expenses of sale and Trustees commissions, the auditor shall allow to Richard E. Zimmerman and Byron W. Thompson, Trustees, an attorneys fee in the amount of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for services performed in these proceedings, and the balance remaining after the allowance for expenses, Trustees commissions and attorneys fees as aforesaid, shall be audited to Richard E. Zimmerman and Byron W. Thompson, Trustees of Silas W. Etzler, an incompetent, and said balance as well as other monies of the incompetent now or hereafter in the hands of said Trustees shall be deposited in an insured savings account at Frederick Federal Savings and Loan Association, and with such interest as may be paid thereon shall be used to pay for the care of said incompetent at Springfield State Hospital and for his maintenance and general welfare, subject to the further Order of the Court.
