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Petition for order to sell
Real Estate.
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TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT.

The petition of T. M. Blickenstaff and Harold N. Blickenstaff, Trustees in the above cause, respectfully represent:

1. That they are the duly appointed Trustees for the estate of Rebecca Blickenstaff, incompetent, in the above cause and are now engaged in the administration of said estate.
2. That the estate of said incompetent consists solely of a farm containing 87.71 acres of land, more or less, located near Wolfesville, in said Frederick County, being all of the same real estate which was conveyed from Charles M. Kline and wife, to said incompetent and her now deceased husband, Harry G. Blickenstaff, by deed dated April 7, 1925, and recorded in Liber No. 436 at folio 443, one of the land records for said Frederick County.
3. That said farm is not in first class condition and at present yields little more than the expenses for taxes, insurance and some necessary repairs.
4. That the children of said incompetent have been supporting their mother as best they can in the homes of the various children, and by contributions from the other children, but feel that the condition of the farm is becoming worse every year and that there is little prospect of its becoming more productive, without the erection of a dairy barn, and the expense of such
