TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The petition and report of sales of real estate made by T. M. Blickenstaff and Harold M. Blickenstaff, Trustees in the above entitled cause, respectfully represents:

1. That they are the duly appointed trustees in said cause and after filing their duly approved bond, with the Clerk of the Circuit, they proceeded to sell the real estate mentioned in said proceedings as follows:
