TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition of Charles F. Hartman, brother of Bernard Bradley Hartman, respectfully represents unto your Honorable Court:

FIRST: That Bernard Bradley Hartman is now confined in the Springfield State Hospital, Maryland, where he ^{has} been for the past four years, having been committed there because of his incompetency.

SECOND: That your Petitioner filed herewith certificates of two medical doctors practicing in the State of Maryland for the last five years, who have attended the said Bernard Bradley Hartman within ten days before the filing of this Petition, said certificates being marked Exhibits Nos. 1 and 2 to this Petition.

THIRD: That a certain John Hartman was the owner of five dwelling houses, being known as Nos. 110, 135, 300, 302 and 302^{1/2} East Third Street, Frederick, Maryland, which, upon his death intestate, some years ago, devolved upon his widow, Mary C. Hartman, and his eight children, one of whom is Bernard Bradley Hartman.

FOURTH: That recently Mary C. Hartman, the widow, died, intestate and now the ownership of the property is in the eight children.

FIFTH: That the real estate has recently been appraised at \$19,500.00.

SIXTH: That your Petitioner believes that it would be to the best interest and advantage that a committee be appointed to manage the one-eighth interest of the said Bernard Bradley Hartman in the estate until same is sold and thereafter Bernard Bradley Hartman's interest in his share of the proceeds.
